RN to Bachelor Degree in Nursing Completer Program

The RN to BSN nursing program does not have programmatic nursing accreditation from accrediting agencies such as the Accreditation Commission for Education in Nursing (ACEN) or the Commission on Collegiate Nursing Education (CCNE). When students graduate from a program that does not have programmatic nursing accreditation, it may impact them in several ways, including but not limited to:

- The student may not qualify for employment if the employer requires nurses to have graduated from a bachelor's degree program that is accredited by ACEN or CCNE.
- The student may not be able to transfer nursing credits to another RN to BSN nursing program.
- The student may not be admitted to any graduate level nursing program that requires graduation from a bachelor's degree program that is accredited by ACEN or CCNE.
